

PERFORMANCE READINESS REHEARSAL (PRR)

If you have missed four or more rehearsals for this concert, you must participate in a special "performance" Monday at the end of rehearsal. Your "audience" will include the Artistic Director and the Section Leaders. You will perform in a group with others (usually at least 20 chorus members) who have also missed rehearsals. If it is obvious to us that you don't know your music or movement at least as well as the rest of the chorus, you may need to take remedial action or not sing in the concert.

Your Section Coordinator will probably be in touch with you over the next few days to remind those members who should attend.

Music selections for the PRR:

Legacy
Destiny Suite (with movement)
O Disturbing Boy

The reason for the PRR is to ensure that everyone is ready to perform. Because we generally rehearse only once a week, your attendance is very important to ensure the artistic health of the organization. We want to make sure that those of you who have missed too many rehearsals are prepared to go on stage alongside your chorus brothers who have perfect attendance. The maximum number of rehearsals you may miss without attending the PRR is outlined in the registration form, which you signed at the beginning of the semester.
